SCHOOL LIBRARY

We have a computerized school library with around 6000 books including variety of standard books, references, dictionaries, encyclopedias and periodicals which help the students to refer and gain more information about the subjects.

SPORTS AND GAMES

In an era where physical training is taking back seat, coaching is given to students in athletics. The children are taken to participate in different inter school tournaments and intra school sports and games.

CONVEYANCE

The school provides transportation facilities to students. The parents who want to send their children to school by school bus should apply for it to the Principal at the beginning of the academic year. The bus fee will be collected in three installments along with the school fee.

The school bus facility should be availed of for an entire term. Commuting by school bus is an occasion for the pupils to cultivate good habits like patience, forbearance, tolerance, sympathy, team spirit, co-operation and consideration for others. Gentlemanly and exemplary behavior is expected of all the students in the bus and at the boarding points where they wait for the bus. Strong and prompt disciplinary action will be taken against the student who misbehaves.

OFFICE

In order to provide the best service, the routine office transactions such as issue of certificates, daily accounts, financial dealings connected with the school are done through the school office which functions from 7.30am to 4.30 pm on regular working days.

CHARITY DRIVE & CASA

To understand the pain and pangs of the homeless, a charity drive is being done every year to construct a home- "Chavara House" for the needy. The school also organizes different charity programmes like visiting the less privileged, providing food and dresses for them, Medical Camp, Educational Scholarship etc.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- **1.** Application forms for admission will be available in the school office. The candidate will be called for test/interview for admission.
- **2.** Admission to kindergarten will be given to selected applicants by the month of September of the previous academic year. There will be no written test for the students seeking admission to the LKG Section.
- **3.** Admission to other classes may be given according to the availability of seats based on an Entrance Test.
- **4.** The students will be tested in their basic knowledge of English, Mathematics, Science, Hindi and Malayalam based on the topics they have learned in the previous year.
 - **5.** The students are free to choose the second language as either Hindi or Malayalam from Std. IX onwards.
 - **6.** The entrance exam is for a duration of two hours and the results will be published on the school website and notice board and can also be enquired over the phone.

Boys: Half sleeve pink shirt, carbon blue shorts, school belt, carbon blue socks, black shoes. Girls: Half sleeve pink shirt, carbon blue pinafore, school belt, carbon blue socks, black shoes.

LP Section

Boys: White half-sleeve shirt, carbon-blue shorts with 1.5" belt loops, Maroon school tie, school belt, black shoes and carbon blue socks.

Girls: White half-sleeve shirt, carbon-blue pinafore with 1.5" belt loops, Maroon school tie, school belt, black shoes and carbon blue socks. Hair plaited into two with maroon ribbon.

UP/ HIGH School Section

Boys: White half-sleeve shirt, carbon-blue pants with 1.5" belt loops, Maroon school tie, school belt, black shoes and carbon blue socks. Girls: White half-sleeve shirt, carbon blue skirt with 1.5" belt loops, carbon blue overcoat, Maroon school tie, school belt, black shoes and carbon blue socks. Hair plaited into two with maroon ribbon.

On Wednesdays

White uniform, white socks and white shoes.

- 7. Short listed candidates will have to appear for an interview with the Principal on the specified day.
 - **8.** The candidate must be accompanied by his/ her parent at the time of interview. Attested copy of the birth certificate of the candidate must be submitted to the office along with their application form in advance.
 - **9.** The students must submit their T. C to the school office at least by the 1st week of June.
 - 10. School Fee must be remitted as three installments at any branch of South Indian Bank or in the Bank Counter at School on specified days.
